**Rector's Action 3/2020**

**on equal treatment of teachers and students of the St.  
Elizabeth University of Health and Social  
Work**

1. This measure serves to protect the highest human values, the dignity of the human person and freedom on the path to education in the spirit of democratic and cultural principles enshrined in the Constitution of the Slovak Republic and the legal order of the Slovak Republic.
2. The St. Elizabeth University of Health and Social Work issues this measure in order to regulate the basic requirements for the conduct and behaviour of students, university teachers and members of the academic community in accordance with Act No.365/2004 Coll. on Equal Treatment in Certain Fields and on Protection against Discrimination and on Amendments and Additions to Certain Acts (Anti-Discrimination Act), as amended.
3. Everyone is obliged to comply with the principle of equal treatment in employment and similar legal relationships and in the provision of educational services.
4. All students are equal in rights and obligations according to the Student Regulations.
5. All university teachers are equal in rights and obligations under the Labour Code.
6. The members of the academic community are equal in rights and obligations according to the relevant provisions of Act No. 131/2002 Coll., on Higher Education and on Amendments and Additions to Certain Acts, as amended.
7. Racial, religious and nationality discrimination is excluded.
8. Students and university teachers on accredited university programmes abroad (Czech Republic, Kenya Cambodia, Federal Republic of Germany and Serbia) are governed by the laws of the country where they are based and are equal in their rights to students and university teachers.

This measure shall enter into force on 1.7.2020
