Rector's Order No. 5/2016

Anti-plagiarism manual

St. Elizabeth University of Health and Social Work in Bratislava

- 1) This order addresses cases of plagiarism among students and university teachers in accordance with Section 62a of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education and on Amendments and Additions to Certain Acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act").
- 2) Thesis, rigorous thesis or habilitation thesis (hereinafter referred to as "thesis") before admission to the defence shall be sent by students and candidates for rigorous or habilitation proceedings to the anti-plagiarism system of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Slovak Republic - the Central Register of Theses, Rigorous Theses and Habilitation Theses (hereinafter referred to as "CRZP").
- 3) The outcome of the CRZP (verification of the degree of originality) is a compulsory part of the student's and applicant's file.
- 4) In the case of a set of published scientific works published by a university, the student or applicant is entitled to insert the publication into the anti-plagiarism system CRZP, WoS, Scopus or ERIH plus before its publication. An exception to points 2.,3.,4. are, in accordance with § 63, paragraph 11 of the Act, theses that have been published as monographs before submission to CRZP, within a periodical or non-periodical publication. This fact shall be demonstrated to the registry operator by an affidavit of the author indicating the title of the publication, its publisher, year of publication, edition, print run and the relevant international standard number (ISBN or ISSN).
- 5) If the originality rate of the thesis shows a concordance of more than 33%, the following procedure is followed:
 - a) from 34%-50% compliance, an additional member is added to the panel,
 - b) Above 50 % agreement, an additional opponent is added,
 - c) above 60 % the thesis will be graded with a grade of FX
 - d) the exception is a publication that has appeared previously *in extenzo* in a journal or proceedings with at least two reviews.

This Order shall enter into force on 1 July 2016
